

### NEW (and evolving) POSITIONS 2016-17

#### Interim Head of School, Scott Kerman

Scott will serve as the Head of School for the 2016-17 school year. Even after a permanent Head of School has been named, Scott will continue as Interim Head of School until June 30, 2017.

#### High School Director, Dan Dunning

This is a new position, replacing the previous High School Coordinator. The High School Director is responsible for directing and overseeing the operations and strategic development of the high school. Dan is your point of contact for all things involving the high school, whether it's matters related to classes, teachers, programming, students, or culture. **Erin Blenkiron** will continue on as the **Activities Director**, responsible for working with students and faculty on high school activities and events, including Retreats and Prom.
